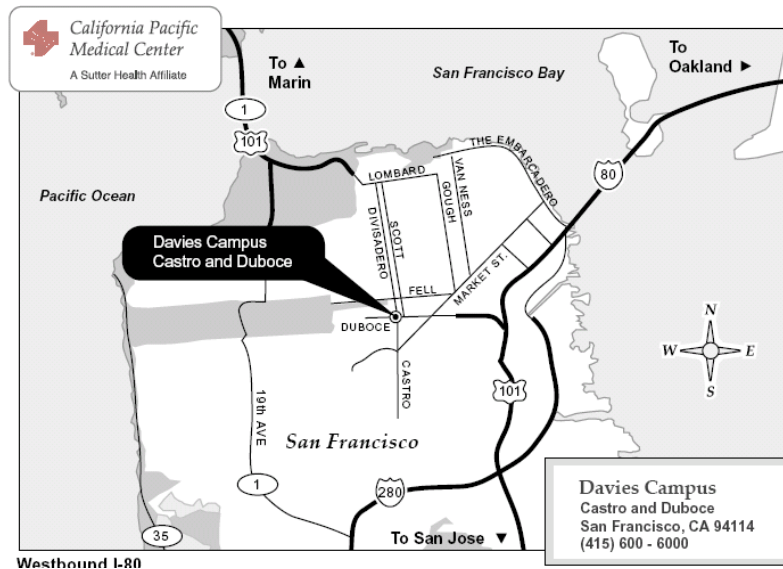

DIRECTIONS



Westbound Hwy 80 (from Oakland)

- Take Hwy 80 over the Bay Bridge
- Take the Ninth Street/Civic Center exit, staying in center exit lane (puts you on Harrison St.)
- Travel 1 block on Harrison and turn right onto 9th Street. On 9th, get into the left hand lanes labeled "Hayes Street"
- 9th Street will veer left into Hayes St. as you cross Market Street
- Follow Hayes St. for approximately 1.5 miles
- Left on Scott St.
- Medical Center entrance is at the end of Scott Street

Northbound Hwy 101 (from San Jose)

- From Hwy 101, take Ninth Street/Civic Center exit
- Travel north on 9th St. and get into the left hand lanes labeled "Hayes Street"
- 9th St. will veer left into Hayes St. as you cross Market St.
- Follow Hayes St. for approximately 1.5 miles
- Left on Scott St.
- Medical Center entrance is at the end of Scott St.

Public Transportation:

The 24 Divisadero, 37 Corbett and the N-Judah stop within one block of the main hospital. For connecting routes, call (415) 673-MUNI. For BART connections, call (650) 992-2278.
